ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR UNACCOMPANIED REFUGEE MINORS (URM) AND YOUNG ADULT REVERIFICATION :

<p>Youth is in URM foster care, is at least age 16, and is likely to remain in foster care until age 18; or</p> <p>Youth has aged out of URM foster care but has not yet turned age 21; or</p> <p>Youth is not yet 21 and adopted from URM foster care after turning age 16; or</p> <p>Youth is not yet 21 and entered URM Permanency Care Assistance after turning age 16; or</p> <p>Young adult is in the URM Extended Foster Care Program.</p> <p>Young adult is working 80 hours a month.</p> <p>Young adult is incapable of performing the activities described above due to a documented medical condition.</p> <p>Youth is enrolled in at least six hours of classes in each regular term.</p> <p>Young adult not enrolled in at least six hours of higher education or vocational or technical classes per semester must participate in or attend another education or work related activity.</p>
